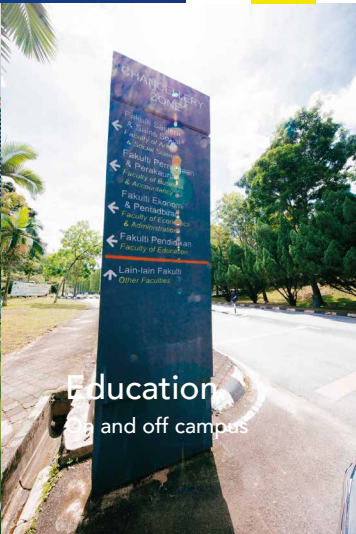
# Living in Kuala Lumpur

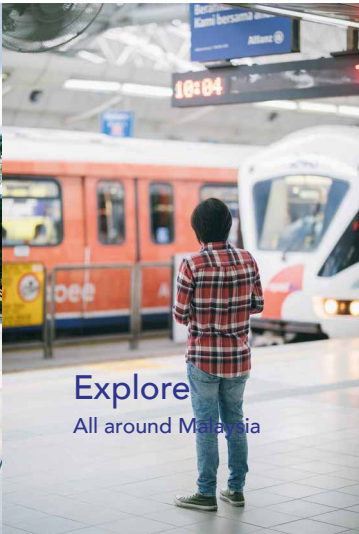

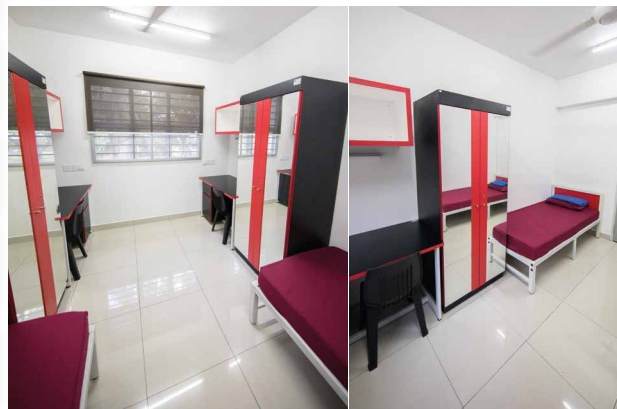

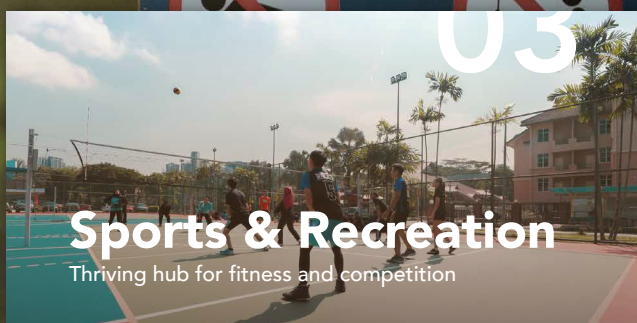
