Candidates are required to acquire a specified number of coursework credits hours. Certain coursework programmes may require the submission of a research report.

Mixed-Mode

Candidates are required to complete a certain amount of coursework credits hours and concurrently produce a dissertation according to the agreed topic by the supervisors and candidate.

Research

Research is the principal requirement, and candidates are expected to produce a dissertation or thesis. Candidates may be required to attend some of the pre-requisite courses as prescribed by the University.

Clinical

Candidates are required to complete coursework credits hours and at the same time be involved with the clinical work that will be assigned from time to time according to courses taken.

Mode of Delivery:

Conventional

Candidates are required to attend all classes. assessments and examinations as outlined for the whole duration of the study programme, be it physically, virtually or in hybrid mode, which is reliant on the latest circular.

Open Distance Learning (ODL)
