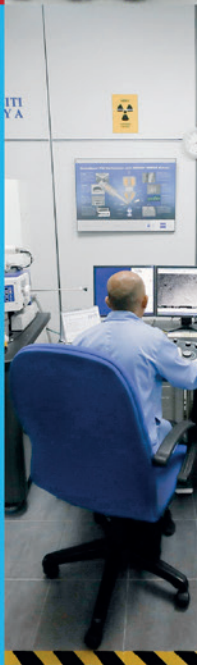

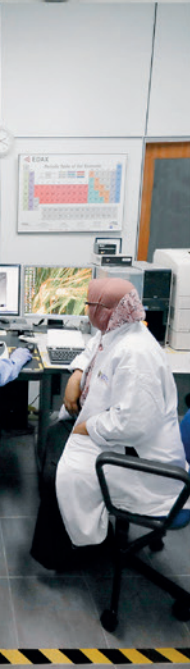

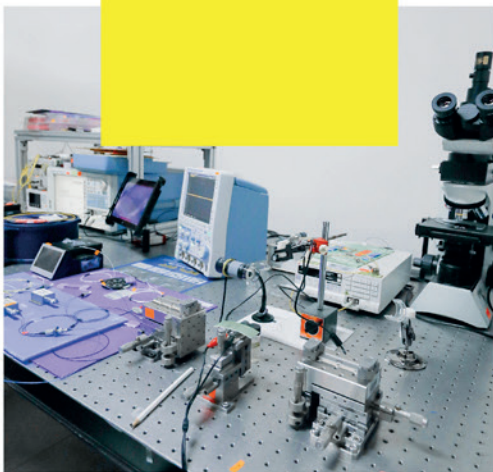

Level of Study

- Master's Degree
- Doctoral Degree

Course Type

• **Coursework:** Candidates are required to acquire a specified number of coursework credits hours. Certain coursework programmes may require the submission of a research report.

• **Mixed-Mode:** Candidates are required to complete a certain amount of coursework credits hours and concurrently produce a dissertation according to the agreed topic by the supervisors and candidate.

• **Research:** Research is the principal requirement, and candidates are expected to produce a dissertation or thesis. Candidates may be required to attend some of the pre-requisite courses as prescribed by the University.

• **Clinical:** Candidates are required to complete coursework credits hours and at the same time be involved with the clinical work that will be assigned from time to time according to courses taken.

Mode of Implementation

• **Conventional:** Candidates are required to attend all classes, assessments and examinations as outlined for the whole duration of the study programme, be it physically, virtually or in hybrid mode, which is reliant on the latest circular.

Mode of Attendance

• **Full-time:** The duration required for the completion of a programme will be depending on the course type and on the progress of the individual candidate.

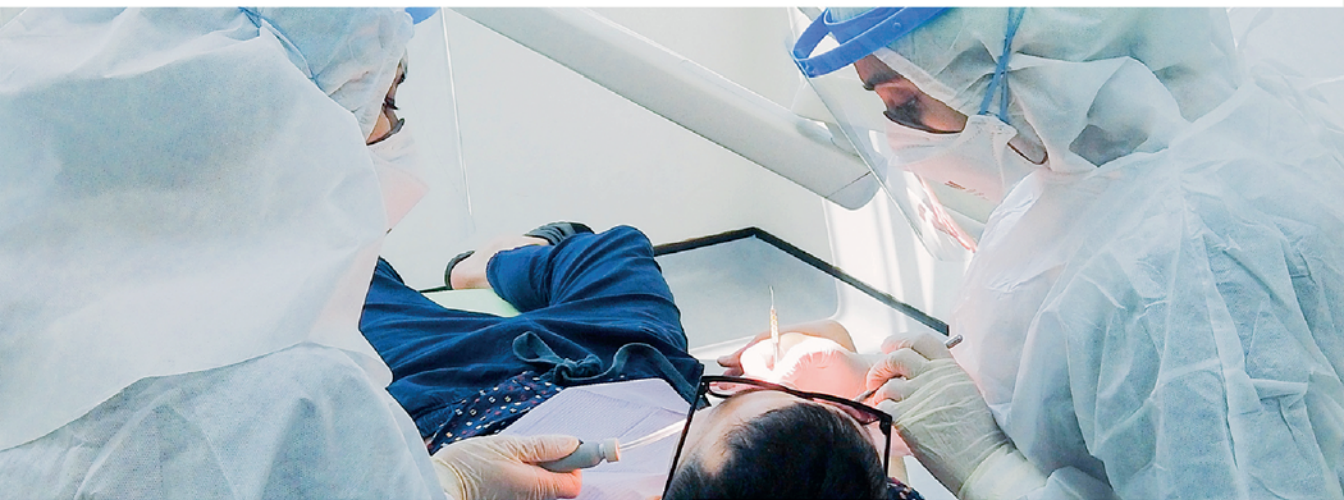

General Entry Requirements

- Master in Public Health with a CGPA of not less than 3.00 or its equivalent; or
- Master in a field related to Public Health with a CGPA of not less than 3.00 or its equivalent; and
- Has relevant work experience of at least one (1) year or for a period as stipulated by the Department from time to time.

Doctoral Degree Programmes

Programme by **Mixed-mode: Doctor of Dental Public Health**

General Entry Requirements

- Master in Community Oral Health from UM with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 or other equivalent qualification recognized; or
- Master of Dental Public Health apart from than Master in Community Oral Health from UM, shall possess a Bachelor of Dental Surgery or other equivalent qualification; and
- Candidate with qualification apart from a Master of Community Oral Health from UM shall pass any other requirements determined by the Faculty from time to time.





Doctoral Degree Programmes

Programme by Coursework: Doctor of Management

General Entry Requirements

- Master's Degree by Research; or
- Master's Degree by Coursework or Mixed Mode with a CGPA of not less than 3.70; or
- Master's Degree by Coursework or Mixed Mode with a CGPA of not less than 3.00 to 3.69 AND a Bachelor's Degree with a CGPA of not less than 3.00; or
- Master's Degree by Coursework or Mixed Mode with a CGPA of not less than 3.00 to 3.69 AND APEL (A) qualification or other qualifications approved by the Senate; or
- Master's Degree by Coursework or Mixed Mode with a CGPA of 2.00 to 3.69 AND
- Bachelor's Degree with a CGPA of 2.50 to 2.99 may be considered if it meets at least one (1) of the following criteria:
 - Has produced publications in the relevant fields;
 - Scholarship recipient;
 - Universiti Malaya graduate;
 - Government agency staff
 - Passed the interview conducted by the Faculty; or
 - Passed the Faculty's special assessment AND
 - Working experience in the management field is not less than five (5) years.

Master's Degree Programmes

Programme by **Clinical: Doctor of Clinical (Dentistry)**

General Entry Requirements

- Master of Oral Science from UM or other equivalent qualifications in the related field; and
- Bachelor of Dental Surgery which is accredited and recognized or an equivalent degree; and
- Has at least two (2) years of working experience in the field of clinical dentistry after being awarded a Bachelor's Degree; and
- An applicant who has a qualification other than the Master of Oral Science from UM shall pass an interview and other requirements set by the Faculty from time to time.



English Language Requirements

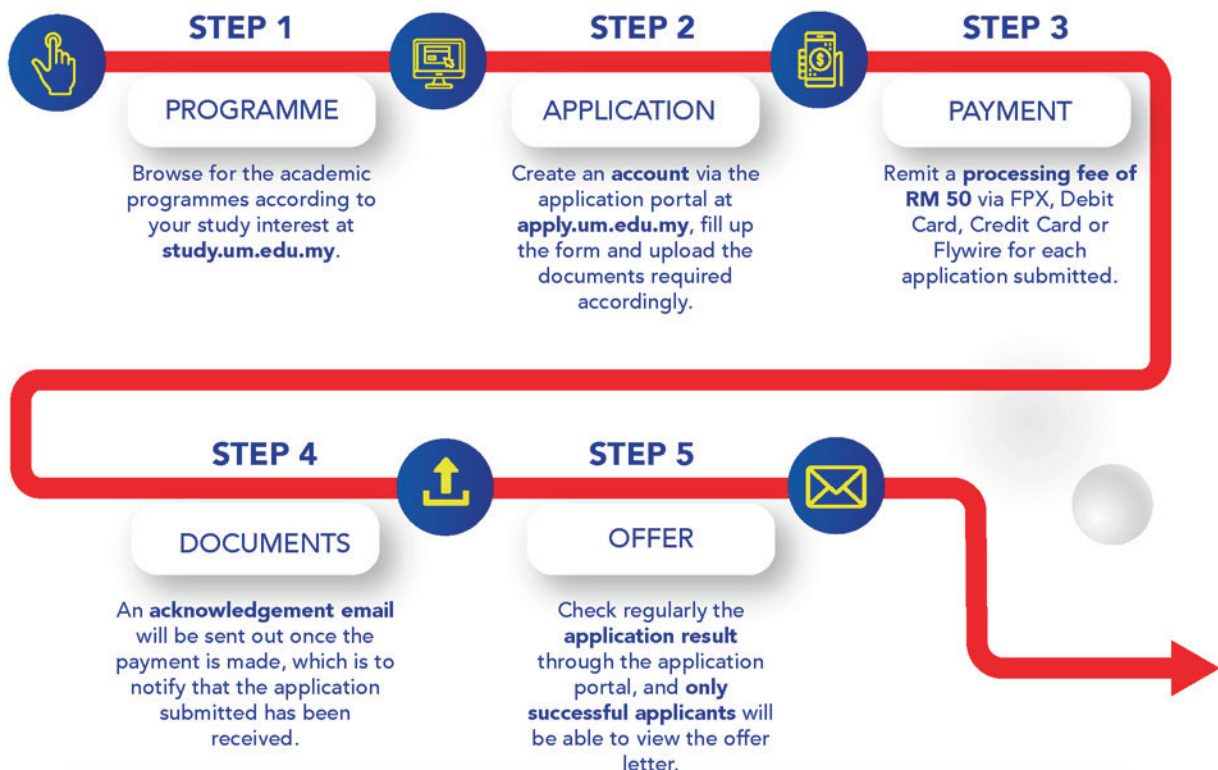
(International Student)

- A minimum score of Band 5.5 for the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) (Academic); OR
- A minimum score of 550 for Paper-based Test (PBT), a score of 213 for Computer- Based Test (CBT) or a score of 80 for Internet-based Test (IBT) for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL); OR
 - A score which according to the programme standard respectively if it is higher than the score set for IELTS (Academic) or TOEFL.
 - For any programmes standard which states that TOEFL or IELTS (Academic) score to be lower than what had been constituted by the university, these programmes have to follow the minimum score set by the university.
- A score of Band 4 and above in the Malaysian University English Test (MUET); OR
- A score of 42 and above in the Pearson Test of Academic English (PTE Academic); OR
- A Grade C and above in English for Advanced Level; OR
- A Grade C and above in the Cambridge Assessment English: First (FCE); OR
- A Grade C and above in the Cambridge Assessment English: Advanced (CAE); OR
- A Grade C and above in the Cambridge Assessment English: Proficiency (CPE).

An exemption may be granted to,

- i Those applicants that originated from a country that uses the English Language as the National Language.
- ii Those applicants that possessed an Academic Qualification from an institution that uses the English Language fully as the medium of instruction.
- iii Those applicants that further their studies in Malaysia and plan to pursue their studies to a higher level and subject to the requirement in number two (ii).

4. Work evidence, research experience, sponsorship/scholarship letter, support letter or professional qualification (if applicable).

- Official translation is required for documents that are not in English or Malay languages.
