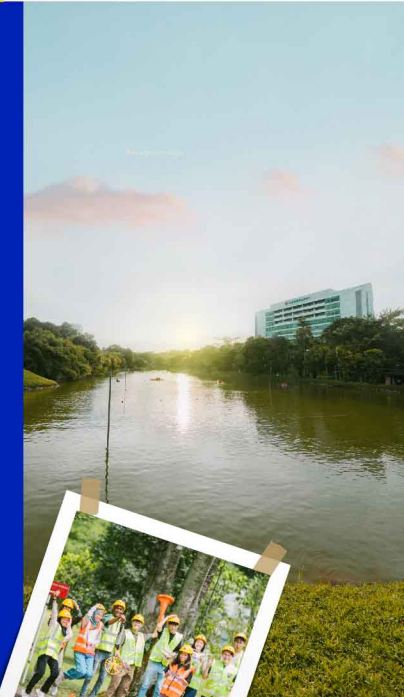


Centre for Integral Learning (CITRA)
